Statement of the Delegation of POLAND

*Mr Chairman,*

Poland subscribes to the EU statement. Let me now give a quick comment in national capacity.

We have listened very carefully to the statements and comments from the floor. It's clear from our deliberations that we still need to clarify the distinction between the notion of automation and autonomy.

Therefore, we believe that there's a need to refine our understanding of assigned levels of human control to use of LAWS. We should agree on critical levels of functions which should never be transferred beyond human control.

We agree also with delegations stating that accountability for use of LAWS should never be delegated to the machines.

As for predictability it could be ensured by establishing human parenting to supervise and control the learning process with code of conduct deriving from IHL, in which case the predictability might be bigger than in humans.
